Our task is to continue to examine our hearts and change ourselves in order to be worthy of his glorious paschal mystery. This is possible only by cooperating with the grace of God and the strengthening of the Holy Spirit through prayer, fasting, and sharing our blessings with those in need.

The First Reading is about how God tested Abraham. God called Abraham and commanded him to take his son Isaac and to go to the land of Moriah to offer him there as a burnt offering on a mountain. Due to his strong faith Abraham obeyed God without hesitation and early in the morning set out towards the mountain. Just when Abraham was about to sacrifice his son, the angel of the Lord told him not to lay his hand on the boy. Abraham obeyed God to the end.

In the Second Reading, Paul speaks to the community that if God is for us, no one can remain against us. It is clear that God was on the side of the faithful and they had nothing to fear. Jesus freely offered up his life in order to show us the enormous love of God for us. God along with Jesus will provide the Christians with all their needs. Since we have Jesus on our side, no one will separate us from the love of Christ.

In the Gospel we have the story of transfiguration of Jesus. The transfiguration reveals the divine identity of Jesus. The three disciples, Peter, James and John are given a glimpse of the real Jesus to help them through the dark and difficult days ahead. It gives us a glimpse of what awaits those who persevere in their living faith. The Transfiguration of Jesus reminds us of the transformation taking place in our lives every tine we receive sacraments. Baptism transforms us into children of God and heirs of heaven. Confirmation transforms us into brave witnesses of and warriors for Christ and Reconciliation transforms sinners into saints.
